



Photography Terms and Conditions

FrameWorthy (Photographer) is the exclusive photographer during the wedding event and/or formal portrait sessions. Other photography is permitted while the photographer is working, however, others wishing to take pictures may do so, but out of the way of the photographer.

FrameWorthy declines other business for the time and date shown in this agreement. In the event of postponement, cancellation or any other change in date and/or times, all retainers paid are nonrefundable and nontransferable.

It is the policy of FrameWorthy to not use associate photographers. However, in the event that FrameWorthy's photographer is unable to photograph the wedding, an associate will be assigned, for no additional charge.

FrameWorthy reserves the right to use all negatives, digital files and prints for display, publication, promotion or other purposes. FrameWorthy reserves the right to remove any prints from previews (blink shots, blurred images, etc.) and to modify images for artistic effect to ensure only quality images.

Reproduction rights remain exclusively with FrameWorthy and are protected under Federal Copyright laws. No unauthorized copies may be made of any prints or enlargements produced by FrameWorthy. This includes electronic scanning or otherwise copying prints, both of which represent violations of existing copyright laws. Client may make unlimited personal copies of images with the purchase of images on CD.

FrameWorthy will strive to capture all agreed-upon wedding day moments. However, due to the spontaneous nature of weddings, and the possibility of equipment failure, FrameWorthy does not promise to deliver any specific image with 100% certainty and no guarantee is expressed or implied.

FrameWorthy cannot be held liable for unintentional errors or omissions on the part of the photographers. FrameWorthy takes great care with respect to exposure, development and delivery of photographs. However, in the unlikely event that FrameWorthy is unable to comply with the terms of this contract, FrameWorthy's liability is limited solely to refund monies already paid by the customer.

FrameWorthy cannot be responsible for incorrectly placed orders. Once an order is placed, all sales are final.

Payment for all portrait sessions is due at the time the contract is signed. We only accept cash, check or money order.

A minimum of \$300 is required to retain the date for a wedding event. The remaining balance outlined in the Wedding Info Sheet must be paid at least two weeks prior to the date of the event. We only accept cash, check or money order.

All events are set as open to the public. If the client desires to have the event password protected, it is up to the client to notify the photographer with the desired password.
